This advocate will also maintain a safe, positive and encouraging environment in all interactions with Engagement participants, community partners, and City Care team members. The right person for this position will consider their role on the team as essential to the best outcomes for our unsheltered neighbors.

#### **Responsibilities:**

Carry out the mission, vision and values of City Care. Know the resources available in the community and support the Advocate in the work to develop a network of contacts. Support the Advocate in the developing individualized plans with participants Support the Advocate in developing a relationship with each participant and promote health and housing at every encounter. The ideal Navigator & Driver will have the ability to be flexible by problem-solving with the team, working face-to-face with individuals in crisis and ensuring that all encounters are safe for all team members and passengers arrive safely to the destination.

#### **Eligibility:**

Embodiment of City Care culture. Understand of the complexity of the intersection of poverty, homelessness, mental illness, substance use and recovery. Ability to reflect recovery principles. Previous experience in a recovery and justice environment. Skilled verbal and written communication. Ability to multitask and handle stressful and complex situations. Ability to work as a member of a team to accomplish shared goals

#### **Requirements:**

Excellent driving record Valid Oklahoma Drivers License. Minimum one year driving experience. Current auto insurance. High school diploma or equivalent. Background check. Medical / vision exam. Lift 25 pounds. Walk up and down stairs unaided. Walk 100 yards unaided. Reliable transportation

#### **Preferred:**

Current Commercial Drivers License with Passenger endorsement. Minimum of one year commercial passenger driving experience. Mental Health Technician. Behavioral Health Aide. Previous Case Management. Days/Hours: Part-time, temporary with the potential for permanent, 20-hours per week, days and hours are negotiable.
